Tentative Title: *Community, Then and Now*

The theme of this exhibit is to engage with the Sandy Spring Museum and its community. Artists will create work through the use of the museum's image archive and paint outs/photoshoots that will incorporate local landscape and residents. 50% of your work on exhibit will be related to the Sandy Spring area.

Nature of Work: Portrait, clothed figure and nude, still life, landscape and pets/animals.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Members may submit original works completed within the last 3 years including drawings, paintings, sculpture and prints. You may exhibit at least 2 works.

The total amount of works per artist will depend on the number of artists participating.

Each exhibiting artist will become a member of the Sandy Spring Museum with free membership for one year.

Entries

Submit at least 2 works; 1 Sandy Spring related & 1 non-related. Total amount will vary depending on number of participating artists.

1. 2-D works may not be larger than 70" in any direction including outside edges of frame. *Work must be framed* and ready to hang with wire and sturdy enough for normal handling. 3-D works must fit 15" square pedestal.
2. Artist's name, title and contact information must attached to back of work.
3. Works previously exhibited in an MSPP show and at Sandy Spring Museum are not eligible.

Submission Format

2. Submit 1 jpeg per work entered; file size: 2-3 megabytes

4. Include in the body of your email:

Entry Fee

Entry fee: Each participating artist will become a member of the museum (for free for a one year duration). There is no entry fee. *You must be an active member with 2017 paid dues.**

Terms for Exhibition

1. Entering this exhibition shall constitute understanding and agreement on the part of the artist with the conditions stated.

2. All work must be professionally presented and ready to be installed. A 2-D work *must have a frame* with a secure wire or hooks on the back to accommodate the gallery's hanging system. *No clip-on or poster frames. No gallery wrapped or painted canvas sides. Entries mounted behind glass without frames will not be accepted. Work not in compliance may be turned away and not allowed in exhibit.*
3. Delivery and pick-up of work is the responsibility of the artist. The artist is responsible for all shipping paperwork, costs, and arrangements. This includes the packing and handling, and delivery for returned works.
4. Measure each work to ensure that it meets size limitations before delivery, include outer edges of frames.
5. Attach label to back with name, title, medium and price. Also include your phone and email address.
6. Arrival of work must be on scheduled delivery date.
7. Pick up of work that is not sold must be picked up on the scheduled pick up date.
8. Sandy Spring Museum Form signed by artist.

Sales

The artist will receive 70% of the sale price with the museum receiving a 30% commission.

Liability

The Sandy Spring Museum is equipped with both a security system and a fire suppression system. However, the administration and staff, individually or collectively, will not be responsible for loss or damage to artwork due to theft, accident, fire or other causes.
